



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**  
**Between**  
**The ITU - APT Foundation of India (IAFI)**  
**&**  
**The ITU Association of Japan (ITU-AJ)**

Vide this MoU the **ITU-APT Foundation of India (IAFI) & the ITU Association of Japan (ITU-AJ)** agree to cooperate in terms of furthering the Aim and Objectives of ITU and APT.

Both the associations are broadly similar to spreading knowledge and raising awareness of ITU and APT in their respective countries. Their main emphases are in cooperation activities between these two organisations. It is therefore logical to get in to the MoU for close cooperation in spreading the knowledge base in ITU and APT framework.

In order to establish the above,

**The ITU - APT Foundation of India (IAFI)** and the **ITU Association of Japan (ITU-AJ)** agree to cooperate in the following areas:

1. To exchange of Information (Print and Electronic Media, internet, Web site, Publications, Directories and other relevant material) between both the associations.
2. Assist and extend support to each other while taking up issues on behalf of members with the institutions and other bodies of similar nature.
3. Jointly conduct research in areas of mutual interest to further the cause of the ITU and APT.

Identification of areas where both,

4. **The ITU - APT Foundation of India (IAFI)** and the **ITU Association of Japan (ITU-AJ)** can work together in Strategic alliance, to promote both the organizations and enhance business co-operation among their respective members.
5. Promote or co-hosting events such as Exhibitions, Conferences, Seminars, workshop etc. to further the cause of the ITU and APT

This MOU becomes effective from (mentioned date) and shall remain effective until either of the two parties request its termination in writing, **giving at least three months notice.**
