

Develop the draft CPM Report with possible technical and regulatory solutions to satisfy the WRC-23 agenda items and topics




Draft CPM Report



The RR Art.5 FAT Software is a tool to consult and analyze the RR Frequency Allocations Table and its associated notes (as they appear in RR Article 5 and in other related texts.

It allows, among other things:


- To trace and compare the evolution of the Article 5 Table and its associated footnotes (from the 2001 Edition onward)
- To extract and modify the National Table of Frequency Allocations for a given geographic area (country), based on the corresponding "International Plan" from RR Art. 5


